

Regulation 3.3 (Dress Code) states that ‘*The dress codes for playing on the green shall be determined by the Management Committee and formally notified to playing members*’.

Dress Requirements	
<u>Common to both sections</u> Regulation bowling shoes. Club shirt. Predominantly white cardigan, fleece, jacket and/or jersey. White or cream bowling waterproofs. Predominantly white/cream hats or baseball caps (plain with club logo/colours).	
<u>Ladies Section</u> Grey bowling trousers, skirts, cropped trousers or shorts White bowling trousers, skirt, cropped trousers or shorts Plain white shirt/blouse with collar, sleeves and club badge	<u>Mens' Section</u> Grey bowling trousers or Shorts. White bowling trousers or Shorts. Plain white shirt with collar, sleeves and club badge. Club blazer and tie are optional.
To be worn for:	
<u>Greys:</u> TVLL, KLV and Kennet League Mixed friendly evening matches Tuesday Points Club competitions (including semi finals) Marking for competitions	<u>Whites:</u> Ladies and Weekend friendly matches Captain v President event Ladies v Gents event County President's and Bannerette matches Finals Day (players and markers)
<u>Club shirt (must be worn):</u> TVLL Kennet League KLV 1st Team Ladies and Men's County Representative matches	<u>Smart Casual (may be worn):</u> Evening Points sessions. Roll-ups - where a match is in play seek the agreement of the Captain of the day. MEBC Club Challenge.

Note

- It is a requirement under county rules that all members of a team be attired in the same dress when taking part in a league or county competition.
- For all friendly and internal club matches players may wear the club shirt if they wish, or a plain white shirt/blouse with the club badge.
- In 2018 the club shirt will become mandatory for all County representative matches. Representative matches include **all** League matches and **all** County competitions.
- In 2019 the club shirt will become mandatory for **all** friendly matches.
