RULES FOR 100-UP COMPETITION

- 1. Each player has 4 woods.
- 2. First named player is challenger.
- 3. The jack is bowled, not placed.
- 4. A small coin or marker is placed directly behind the centred jack. If the jack is moved during play it is replaced on the marked spot before the next bowl is played.
- 5. No visits to the head on the Fixed Day only.
- 6. At the completion of each end shots are awarded thus:

1.	Shot wood	4 points
2.	2nd wood	3 points
3.	3rd wood	2 points
4.	4th wood	1 point

- 7. The player with the shot wood is awarded the mat on the following end.
- 8. The Winner is the first player to reach 100 shots.

N.B. There cannot be a tie on the final end as shots are always awarded in order, and therefore one player will reach 100 first.
