

WELFARE NOTICES

Health and Safety

- Members should be aware that while on MEBC premises they must take responsibility for their own personal safety and that of others and should take due care and attention at all times.

Accidents

- Should an accident occur, either on or off the green, it must be recorded in the Accident Book in the lobby;
- If an injury results in the need for medical assistance the Club Secretary or a Club Officer must be notified as soon as possible.

Bowls Bags

- Bowls and bowls bags must not be left in the lounge or bar areas;
- Bowls and bowls bags must not be taken into the Clubroom or left in the Lobby;
- Passageways and pathways must be kept clear of obstruction;
- Any member seeing a potential tripping hazard is required to make it safe.

Bowling Green

- A notice will be displayed when the Green has been treated. In which case bowlers will need to take care not to transfer chemicals that may be on the surface of the Green onto their skin or mouth;
- When wet the brick edges to the Green are slippery. Take care when stepping on and off the green. Steps are available at the corners of the green.

First Aid

- First Aid boxes are kept in the Lobby and in the kitchen.

Visitors

- It is imperative that all visitors whether it is for a trial, to play or just visiting, sign the Visitors' Book countersigned by the responsible member. This is essential for insurance cover and licencing.
